Beginning Russian. Level 1.	<i>Mrs. Lisa Danilova-Libby</i> (this class is for heritage speakers)	Tuesday-Thursday, from 4 pm to 4:45 pm	Highly interactive class with elements of games, role-plays, and kids' active participation. The focus is on engagement, on fostering interest in the Russian language, and vocabulary building. Children will be discovering the worlds through <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Word games • Reading books • Practicing expressing ourselves in Russian through writing There will be creative tasks to encourage kids to use the language, to build their confidence in speaking Russian, and showing how fun it can be. As one of the parents said: "Mrs. Danilova is a great teacher. Her instructions are fun and engaging. My son was sad when the session was over."
	<i>Mr. Sergey Ermasov</i>	Monday-Wednesday, from 4:30 pm to 5:15 pm	Students are introduced to Russian vocabulary, basic grammar, and sentence structure through games, small books, and situational role-plays.
	<i>Mrs. Irina Lorenz</i>	Wednesdays, from 3:30 pm to 4:15 pm and Saturdays, from 1:00 pm to 1:45 pm.	Class is conducted interactively with elements of games, role-plays, and similar activities. Beginning Russian. Level 0. Absolute beginners	<i>Mrs. Lana Spencer</i>	Tuesday- Thursday, 6:15 pm to 7:00 pm Enrollment limit: 3 students	You wanted to study Russian but thought it is too hard? Take this class for absolute beginners. At the end of the class, students will be able to recognize letters and read simple sentences, distinguish adjectives, and talk about their families.

Intermediate Russian	<i>Mrs. Iryna Dovzhanska</i>	Mondays and Thursdays 7:00 pm - 7:45 pm Enrollment limit: 6-7 students.	<p>In this course, students will practice decoding Cyrilling alphabet along with listening and speaking skills via Russian interactive activities, action songs, and cartoons. Some elements of geography and culture including relevant Russian terminology will be introduced through hands-on projects.</p> <p>Supplies needed: colored pencils, markers</p>

	<i>Mrs. Tatyana Ivanoff</i>	Monday-Wednesday, 6:00 pm to 6:45 pm	Уроки русского языка для детей этого возраста проводятся на основе учебника русского языка Т. Рамзаевой, по которому дети учатся в России, начиная со второго класса. Ребята уже изучают синтаксис, т.е. типы предложений, члены предложения, словосочетания, состав слова. Уроки начинаются с разминки, т.е. 10 минут мы говорим на различные темы (какая погода, что нового и хорошего произошло и т.д.), затем проверяем домашнее задание, которое ученики обязательно выполняют дома, закрепляя материал прошлого урока. Затем дается новая тема урока по учебнику, ребята учат грамматику, правильное произношение новых слов, орфографию, чтение текстов, отвечают на вопросы учителя и сами учатся вести диалоги и небольшие рассказы по теме урока. Ребята с удовольствием читают стихи русских поэтов и выступают на концертах и праздниках школы.

Minimum enrolment: 2 students;	By the end of the course students will be able to discuss their daily activities, hobbies, school life, food and shopping etc, read and write using complex sentences and understand longer texts on more sophisticated topics.
